



TRADE SCHOLARSHIP FUND APPLICATION SPRING 2024

This Modesto Chamber of Commerce Foundation Trade Scholarship Fund is designed to support students looking to continue their education toward a Vocational Trade. Each scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1,000.

A trade job is defined as a job that is a specialized craft that requires advanced training and education. Trade workers receive their education and training through apprenticeships, on-the-job training, specialized education programs, and/or vocational schools.

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS:

- The applicant resides in the greater Stanislaus County region.
- The applicant is seeking a certificate or degree in Vocational Trades, (*Construction School, Automotive School, Culinary School, Cosmetology School, etc.*)
- High school, college, re-entry or continuing student.
- Completed application.
- The applicant must provide a one-page essay (not to exceed 500 words) see below.
